The building at 1112 W Jefferson St is a one-story single-family house built in 1890, according to the historical marker associated with the property. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. The house displays features that are associated with the Folk Victorian style, a domestic architectural expression that relied on the use of applied architectural ornamentation on more traditional house forms. It has an L-shaped plan with a front-projecting wing on the front facade. The building has a cross-gabled roof. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: masonry piers, classical columns. Landscape feature(s) include the following: plantings. A secondary back house is at the rear of the lot.
