Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 1314 W Main St is a two-story single-family house built about 1925, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains

unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. It displays features associated with the Craftsman movement, which was popularized in magazines and pattern books from the early- to mid-twentieth century. Its plan is indicative of a bungalow, a domestic house form that was popular from the 1910s to the 1930s. The building has a front-gabled roof. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway. Porch feature(s) include the following: wood box columns. The only ancillary building on the property is a shed.
