Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 611 W Marvin Ave is a two-story single-family house built in 1907, according to the historical marker associated with the property. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. It displays features associated with the Craftsman movement, which was popularized in magazines and pattern books from the early- to mid-twentieth century. The building's distinctive modified L-plan form includes an irregular building footprint with a hipped roof and projecting gable roofs on the front and side. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Door feature(s) include the following: sidelights, transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: tapered wood box columns. Landscape feature(s) include the following: walkways. Ancillary buildings on the property include a garage and back house.
