# **Architectural Description**

## **General Architectural Description:**

The building at 700 S Rogers St is a one-story single-family house built about 1895, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. With its elaborate exterior detailing and use of varying textures and materials, the building is indicative of the Queen Anne style, which was popular during the late nineteenth century. The building's distinctive modified L-plan form includes an irregular building footprint with a hipped roof and projecting gable roofs on the front and side. The building has a side-gabled roof. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: turned wood posts, jigsawn trim. The only ancillary building on the property is a shed.
