### **Architectural Description**

## **General Architectural Description:**

The building at 103 E University Ave is a two-story single-family house built about 1905, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. The building's style is indicative of the Classicial Revival movement, which was popular during the early twentieth century and relied on forms and detailing associated with Greek and Roman architectural traditions. The building has a massed plan, a form that is multi-rooms deep and multi-rooms wide, often with a rectangular footprint. The building has double-hung windows. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms, sidelights. Porch feature(s) include the following: classical columns. Landscape feature(s) include the following: fencing, plantings, walkways. The only ancillary building on the property is a shed.
