Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 514 Water St is a one-story single-family house built in 1895, according to the historical marker associated with the property. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. The house displays features that are associated with the Folk Victorian style, a domestic architectural expression that relied on the use of applied architectural ornamentation on more traditional house forms. It has an L-shaped plan with a front-projecting wing on the front facade. The building has a cross-gabled roof. The building has a brick external chimney. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The primary entrance is a single doorway with wood framing and other other similar entries. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms, sidelights. Porch feature(s) include the following: turned wood posts, jigsawn trim.
